The case of the petitioners is that clause 6.2 of the advertisement dated 31.12.2024, which arbitrarily sets the upper age limit at 45 years as of 01.01.2024, is unjust. The petitioners further assert that they qualified the eligibility examination held in 2018/2023, and as such, their age should be reckoned from the date of eligibility.

On taking steps, let service be effected upon respondent No.3.

The respondent Nos.1 and 2 shall allow the petitioners to participate in the selection process. Liberty is also granted to the petitioners to fill up the examination form.
