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ORDER

Heard.

2] This petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 226 of the Constitution of India, against the order of externment dated 20.11.2025, passed by the District Magistrate, Indore, whereby, the petitioner, a practicing Advocate has been externed from Indore and its contiguous districts for a period of six months.

3] Admittedly, the petitioner has not availed the remedy of appeal available to him under the provisions of Rajya Suraksha Adhiniyam, 1990.

4] Counsel for the petitioner has also submitted that he is ready to file an appeal, however, till the appeal is decided, the order of externment dated 20.11.2025 may be stayed, as the petitioner is a practicing Advocate, and if his activities in and around Indore are restrained, it would cause serious prejudice to his clients also.



5] Counsel for the State, on the other hand, has opposed the prayer, and it is submitted that looking to the criminal antecedents of the petitioner, no case for any interim relief is made out.

6] On due consideration of submissions, and perusal of the documents filed on record, this Court is not inclined to exercise its extraordinary jurisdiction to pass any interim order in favour of the petitioner.

7] However, the petitioner shall be at liberty to seek stay of the impugned order before the Appellate Authority, which shall be decided by the Appellate Authority, without being influenced by the rejection of petitioner's prayer for interim relief in this petition.

8] It is also directed that if an appeal is preferred by the petitioner within a week's time, the same shall be decided by the Appellate Authority, preferably, within a month's time.

9] With the aforesaid, the petition stands *disposed of*.
