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ORDER

Per. Justice Vivek Agarwal

Ms.Anjulata Patle, Superintendent of Police, Special Police Establishment, Jabalpur submits that preliminary inquiry was ordered when file was lost and the delinquent Shri Oskar Kindo, who was working on the post of In-charge DSP and substantive post was inspector admitted his guilt in regard to loss of original file.

We fail to understand that why FIR was not lodged for loss of original file.

We direct Director General of Police, Special Police Establishment, Bhopal to lodge the FIR today itself and report the matter to this Court. Let action be taken against the delinquent. He is also directed to initiate departmental enquiry as 4 years time has not yet been lapsed since his



retirement.

Learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of this petition.

Revision petition is accordingly dismissed as withdrawn.

However, directions given above shall be complied with within 3 days and report shall be furnished by Shri Sanjay Sarwate, advocate to this Court through the Registry of High Court.
