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ORDER

This is the first bail application filed by the applicant under Section 483 of B.N.S.S. for grant of regular bail relating to Crime No.346/2025 registered at Police Station - Kotwali, District Damoh (M.P.) for the offence punishable under Sections 4/5 of Explosive Substance Act. Applicant is in detention since 17.05.2025.

2. As per the prosecution story, it is alleged that applicant along with other co-accused were having explosive material in their possession. Therefore, aforesaid sections has been registered against him.

3. Learned counsel for the applicant submitted that applicant is innocent and has been falsely implicated. He is in jail since 17.05.2025. Co-accused Arbaz Khan and Monu Raikwar have been enlarged on bail by the trial Court. Seizure witness Sarfaraz Khan (PW-2) has been examined before the trial Court in which he has not supported the prosecution story. Trial will



take considerable time. Therefore, it has been prayed that the applicant may be released on bail.

4. On the other hand, learned counsel for State has opposed the grant of bail to the applicant and prayed for its rejection on the ground of criminal antecedents.

5. Having taken into consideration all the facts and circumstances of the case, but without commenting on merits of the case, I am inclined to release the applicant on bail. Consequently, bail application under Section 483 of B.N.S.S. for grant of bail filed on behalf of applicant, stands allowed.

6. It is directed that applicant be released on bail on his furnishing a personal bond in the sum of Rs.50,000/- (**Rupees Fifty Thousand only**) with one solvent surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court, for his regular appearance before the trial Court during trial with a condition that he shall remain present before the concerned Court on all the dates fixed by it during trial. He shall abide by all the conditions enumerated under Section 480(3) of B.N.S.S.

7 . This order shall be effective till the end of the trial. However, in case of bail jump and breach of any of the conditions of bail, it shall become ineffective.
