Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that, he is aggrieved of registration of FIR by EoW on 26.02.2026 at Police Station EoW, Bhopal bearing No. 0038 of 2026 under Section 318(4), 61(2), 238(c) of the Bhartiya Nyay Sahinta , 2023 and Section 7(c) of Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988 as amended in the year, 2018 on account of nonpayment of Tax dues of certain vehicles plied by the petitioner.

Let personal affidavit of the Director General, EoW and that of the Legal Advisor of EoW be filed, to show that how a case of Tax Evasion will fall under the preview of Section 7 of the Prevention of Corruption Act or any of the provisions of BNSS under which FIR has been registered.

Let this affidavit be filed positively within 07 days, for which Shri Rajeshwar Rao shall facilitate the needful.

List this case on 17.03.2026, top of the list.

It is made clear that, if the affidavit is not filed on or before 16.03.2026, then this Court may order for personal presence of the Director General and Legal Advisor of EoW.
