Heard on the question of admission as well as interim relief.

Issue notice to the respondents upon payment of the process fee within seven working days by speed post, returnable within four weeks. Failure to do so shall result in the dismissal of the petition without further reference to the Court.

In addition let a copy of the petition along with annexures and a copy of this order be supplied to Shri Manu Maheshwari, Advcoate who normally appears for the respondent No.3 who may seek instructions in respect of the grievance of the petitioner. Registry is directed to reflect the name of Shri Manu Maheshwari, Advocate on behalf of the M.P Employees Selection Board.

As an interim measure, it is directed that although the petitioners have already participated in the examination and their results have been declared, their primary apprehension remains the document verification process. Specifically, the petitioners opted for the "Special Category Teacher" designation, even though it was not included in the original advertisement. Consequently, they fear their candidatureship may be rejected for failing to hold an RCI-recognized Special Education Diploma Certificate. Since the

petitioners remain otherwise eligible for the advertised post of Primary Teacher, the respondents are directed not to reject their candidatures solely on the basis of the missing certificate. This arrangement shall remain subject to the filing of a formal reply by the opposing side.
