Counsel for the petitioner submits that he has lodged an e-FIR in which he mentioned the names of all the culprits and miscreants; however, the police have registered the FIR only against selected persons. It is further submitted that the FIR has not been registered in accordance with the contents of the e-FIR uploaded by the petitioner, and that the respondents have diluted the allegations made therein. Learned counsel further submits that the petitioner's statement under Section 161 of the Cr.P.C. has not been recorded till date.

In view of the aforesaid, counsel for the State is directed to submit a status report/response. The Investigating Officer is also directed to ensure that, whenever the petitioner's statement is recorded, it shall be recorded in front of a video camera.

Issue notice to respondent Nos. 5 to 14 on payment of PF within a week.
