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ORDER

Per. Justice Subodh Abhyankar

The present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is filed in the nature of habeas corpus.

2. Pursuant to the order dated 27.07.2026, the Corpus has been brought today before this Court and on the query made by this Court, she has informed that she has also solemnized marriage with the petitioner and expressed her willingness to accompany the petitioner.

3. Petitioner/husband - Saransh Jogchand is also present in person and he has also stated that he is ready and willing to take the Corpus with him.

4. In view of the aforesaid, since the age of the Corpus is also 28 years and she has stated her occupation as a practising Advocate, we are



inclined to allow the Corpus to accompany the petitioner.

5. Since the Corpus has expressed her willingness to accompany the petitioner, therefore, no further order is required to be passed in the present habeas corpus petition.

6. The respondents/State is also directed to ensure that the petitioner and Corpus, who have solemnized their marriage against the wishes of the family members of Corpus be protected, as and when required and for this purpose, the Station House Officer of the concerned Police Station shall also share his phone number to the petitioner and Corpus.

7. With the aforesaid, the writ petition stands disposed of.
