Akash Kumar Vs Central Bureau of Investigation & Ors.

Fresh application/complaint under Section 175(3) of BNSS, 2023 received. It be checked and registered.

Present: Advocate Manmeet Singh for applicant Akash Kumar.

This is fresh application/complaint filed by applicant/complainant Akash Kumar containing allegations that respondent No.2/Rahul Bansal, an officer of Indian Police Service (IPS), hatched a criminal conspiracy with certain other junior police officials (respondent No.3 & 4) and acting in furtherance of the said conspiracy, these police officials demanded & accepted bribe of more than Rs.1 crore through *hawala* channel. Applicant has prayed for the registration of an FIR under Section 7 & 7A of PC Act and Section 308 & 351 of BNS, 2023.

The application is accompanied with an affidavit.

Counsel for the applicant has alleged inaction on the part of the concerned police officials despite lodging a complaint dated 08.06.2026. She has submitted that a written complaint was lodged with the Director, Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) but no action has been taken. Copy of the said complaint has been filed along with the present application.

Respondent No.2 is stated to be an IPS officer, who is presently posted as Superintendent of Police, Ambikapur (Chhattisgarh)

while respondent No.3 & 4 are stated to be Sub-Inspectors posted at PS Cyber Thana, Sarguja, Ambikapur (Chhattisgarh).

Keeping in view the mandate of Section 175(4) of BNSS, issue notice of the present application to respondent No.1 to 4. In terms of Section 175(4)(b) of BNSS, respondent No.2, 3 & 4 are at liberty to submit their respective assertions as to the situation that led to the incident so alleged. Further, since the complaint contains allegations of corruption by the public servants, report in terms of Section 175(4)(a) of BNSS containing facts & circumstances of the incident be called from the Director General of Police (DGP), Chhattisgarh, who is stated to be the officer superior to respondent No.2.

Action Taken Report be also called from the Director, CBI in respect of complaint dated 08.06.2026.

Copy of the complaint/application as well as annexures be forwarded to the concerned authorities/officers and respondents.

Put up for report/arguments on 17.07.2026.
